d'Arenberg, one of the undisputed kings of Australian Shiraz and Rhone varietals, was established in the famed McLaren Vale region in 1912, and has since passed down through four generations to current winemaker Chester Osborn. Robert Parker commented in 2002 that, "this is one of South Australia's most renowned wineries and an institution in McLaren Vale."

BALGOWNIE ESTATE *Bendigo, Victoria*

Balgownie Estate is one of Australia's greatest small vineyard estates. Located near the historic gold mining town of Bendigo in central Victoria, the Estate was established in 1968 on a site of top alluvial soil. Now the most respected name in the region, the wines are benchmarks of a Victorian style reliant on well-ripened fruit, distinctive local terroir and sympathetic use of oak.

A benchmark Australian winery founded in 1970 by Sydney trio Tony Albert, John Beeston and Australia's leading wine critic, James Halliday, Brokenwood evolved from a weekend venture for these self-professed hobby winemakers into one of Australia's most reputable wine labels. 35 years later, Brokenwood is known for producing some of Australia's most long-lived Semillons, and one of the nation's most iconic single vineyard wines, the Graveyard Shiraz.

CHAMBERS ROSEWOOD *Rutherglen, Victoria*

Since establishment in 1858 in Victoria's famed Rutherglen region, winemaking duties at Chambers Rosewood have been handed down through five generations. These wines are a national treasure; wines expertly crafted from unctuous material that has matured in the family cellars for more than a century. Robert Parker summed it up best in 2001: "Anyone who has ever tasted Chambers fortified Tokay or Muscat realizes the world's reference point for these wines begins and ends with Chambers."

GIANT STEPS *Yarra Valley, Victoria*

Giant Steps was established in 1998 in the cool-climate Yarra Valley region by wine industry veteran Phil Sexton. With the aim of creating single vineyard wines reflecting a unique sense of place, the 75 acre vineyard was hand-planted on the gravelly, north facing slopes of the Warramate Ranges. A decade later, the wines are renowned for offering length rather than breadth, finesse rather than largesse, and above all, fruit rather than artifact.

INNOCENT BYSTANDER *Victoria, Australia*

Phil Sexton relocated to the gravelly slopes of Victoria's Yarra Valley in the late 1990's. Beyond the pristine fruit of the Yarra Valley, he discovered numerous Central Victorian vineyards that inspired the Innocent Bystander range. These wines have a personality all of their own: distinctly regional, expressive and definitely not your run of the mill varietal blends.

JASPER HILL, OCCAM'S RAZOR, CAMBRIEN & AGLY BROTHERS *Heathcote, Victoria*

Jasper Hill, established in 1975 by Ron and Elva Laughton, produces some of Australia's most individual and compelling Shirazes. Situated on ancient Cambrian soils in the Heathcote region of Central Victoria, the dry-farmed, biodynamic vineyards have been largely responsible for establishing the area as one of Australia's greatest red wine regions. A long-standing friendship and shared winemaking philosophy has since seen the Laughtons partner with Michel Chapoutier, jointly crafting the Agly Brothers label from Chapoutier's Cotes du Roussillon vineyards in Southern France, and the Cambrien Shiraz from the Laughton's Heathcote vineyards in Central Victoria.

KILIKANOON *Clare Valley, South Australia*

Founded in 1997 by Kevin Mitchell, Kilikanoon is a boutique Clare Valley winery with an international reputation for producing regionally expressive, terroir-driven wines. Mature vineyards of Shiraz, Cabernet, Grenache and Riesling planted by Kevin's father, Mort in the 1960's, form the heart of the estate vineyards. At just 10 years of age, Kilikanoon is rated by worldwide critics as one of Clare's leading wineries, producing long-lived Rieslings, and powerful Shiraz, Grenache and Cabernet Sauvignon.

MOUNT MARY *Yarra Valley, Victoria*

Mount Mary, the hallowed name in Australian wine circles and one that many Australian winemakers and critics use when referencing wine styles. The late Dr John Middleton was a pioneer of the Yarra Valley's renaissance in the late 1960's, crafting wines that epitomized elegance and finesse. The Quintet is regarded as Australia's most collectible cabernet sauvignon, granted 'exceptional' classification by Australia's leading wine auction house, alongside Penfolds Grange.

PENLEY ESTATE *Coonawarra, South Australia*

Penley Estate is located in the heart of Australia's greatest Cabernet wine region: Coonawarra. Established in 1988 by Kym Tolley, a direct descendant of the pioneering Penfold and Tolley winemaking families, Coonawarra's famed terra rossa soils were selected for their ability to produce terroir-driven wines of true regional character. The estate is now widely regarded as one of the region's leading producers.

Named after the local Shire of Plantagenet, the winery was founded in 1968 when English immigrant Tony Smith planted vines on his Mount Barker property. These early wines impressed with their elegance and finesse, and Plantagenet has gone on to become a driving force in establishing this area as a distinctive, quality-focused Australian wine region.
