95 pts “Equally clean, but a more expressive palate thanks to the higher percentage of sauvignon blanc (80%) and more oak, though it (the oak) is totally integrated and balanced. Very different from Mangan Vineyard.”

90 pts “Cullen’s vineyards are certified biodynamic. In Margaret River’s cool climate, their white wines are the stars, the 2006 Sauvignon Blanc (80%) – Semillon (20%) being a prime example. Fermented with native yeasts, it exhibits a superb bouquet of mineral, citrus, and lemon-lime. Dry, crisp, and vibrant on the palate, it has layers of ripe fruit, superb balance, and a long, intense finish. Drink it over the next 1-2 years.”

90 pts “Green-gold color. Spicy citrus, yellow apple and mint on the nose, with a deeper note of beeswax. Firm, dry and energetic citrus flavors display impressive cut and thrust. The very long finish is dominated by minerals. This was partially barrel-fermented but there’s no oak showing today.”
