Background/Vintage

The 75 acre Giant Steps vineyard is on the north face of the Warramate Ranges in the central Yarra Valley, an hour east of Melbourne. Established across a series of ridges rising from the 300 to 1000 foot level, the vineyard is planted to rocky/gravelly clays.



Winemaking/Tasting Notes

A single vineyard wine only produced in exceptional and warm years from the highest slopes of the Giant Steps vineyard. Here the conditions are extreme, the vines receiving more than their fair share of direct sunlight as well as reflected light from the flinty rocks that cover the ground and from the lake below.

The nose offers up aromas of cassis, cherry, chocolate liqueur, blackcurrant and vanilla bean qualities. The palate is tight, highlighting blackcurrant, cedar, clove mixed spice and vanilla characteristics.
