89 pts “Glass-staining purple. Spicy red- and blackcurrant, olive, violet and tobacco aromas are classic expressions of syrah. Round and sweet, offering deep dark berry flavors and notes of cola and candied flowers. Plump, juicy and tannin-free, with very good finishing cling and sweetness. Serve this fruit bomb with a peppery grilled steak.”
